



GETTING STARTED WITH MINT

First Colorado National Bank offers connectivity to Mint by linking with your online banking account.

Link your Online Banking Account with Mint

By linking your account, you will authorize Mint to automatically download transactions from your financial institution by providing Mint with your online banking credentials.

- 1) Sign up for an account at mint.com
- 2) Open a web browser and log into Mint at mint.com.
- 3) Click Accounts.
- 4) Enter First Colorado National Bank in the search field, then click Search.

- 5) Mint will display a list with the search results. Select **First Colorado National Bank** from the results list. This will display a login window for First Colorado National Bank.

- 6) Enter the credentials you use to access your FCNB online banking, then click **Connect Securely**. Mint will establish a secure connection and download your account data.

Update Transactions

Mint automatically updates your linked bank account data when you log into your Mint account. The Accounts list shows a timestamp for its most recent update.

If you are in mid-session, you can update your accounts by navigating to the Accounts menu and clicking the **Refresh icon**.
